Hertfordshire Updates

New Sessions in Herts

The introduction of new Walking Netball and Back to Netball sessions at the Furzefield Leisure Centre (part of the Hertsmere Leisure group) have been met with big attendances and high levels of enthusiasm.

Hertsmere has traditionally been difficult to set up new netball programmes even though there is a high demand for netball for all ages and abilities. In order to provide netball to meet this demand a new working partnership was formed with Hertsmere Leisure, Hertsmere Borough Council and the Netball Development Officer for Hertfordshire Oliver Buncombe.

The projects aimed to run two sessions at the Furzefield Leisure Centre, one Walking Netball and one Back to Netball session. These sessions run on week nights with Back to Netball running Friday evenings from 7-8pm and Walking Netball Mondays 11:30am-12:30pm.

The sessions are now attracting fantastic and consistent numbers with Back to Netball bringing in up to 27 people per week and Walking Netball also reaching over 20 people from the surrounding communities. Both of these sessions are still open to new attendees with the potential to run more sessions if the sessions become oversubscribed.

Disability Netball Education Workshop

Last weekend Herts County Netball Association in association with England Netball held their first ever Disability Netball Education Workshop. The workshop lasted just over two hours and sought to upskill and develop teachers, coaches, volunteers, players and many more in disability netball.

The workshop covered both practical and theory elements covering a wide number of disabilities including visual impairment, deaf netball, amputee, cerebral palsy and learning disabilities. Matthew Dunstan, National Disability Development & Delivery Manager for England Netball kindly led the workshop using his many years of experience in the sports disability sector to develop understanding, answer questions and deliver the workshop.









Attendees to the session all stated that they had a great time and would be keen to participate in more workshops like this in the future. It was also mentioned that they all had a new appreciation and renewed vigour for inclusion of people with disabilities and the development of sessions for people with disabilities. Plans are already underway for new workshops in the county, this time with a more specific focus on a certain disability per course and a larger practical element.

Walking Netball in Bedfordshire

"The reason I love walking netball is for the fun element. We just laugh the whole time, during and after the game. We follow the 'rules' but it's not



implemented too much so makes the game flow and feels informal. Everyone that comes just fits right in to our group, and I do think, we as a group make anyone of any age, or ability fit right in. I do believe that if it was too competitive it would take the enjoyment out of it. We laugh on



and off of the court, at ourselves or with each other. The coach has a big part in how the session's feels, I think we just feed off each other. If the coach was too strict or serious the group dynamics would alter. In fact our coach is the glue that keeps us all together, that makes us all feel welcome and happy. Everyone loves Sachel."

"We all communicate on a WhatsApp group chat and that is a good source of support (and laughs) throughout the week. The coffee and cake afterwards is a really good part of it, the part where you can really make friends, and laugh about the session. I can imagine to some people it would be a great place to receive support. Some of the women are just so excited to be able to play netball once again after they thought they were unable to play anymore due to fitness/age. The joy and content they have is really nice to see."





"Our group has also seen ex players reunite after playing together years before, it's nice seeing them reconnect through the love of their sport. It's really interesting seeing really skilled slightly older players with us new players who are maybe younger but without the years of experience of playing, sharing ideas and combining skills to make a happy team." - Tracy Palmer, Silsoe Walking Netball Session.
