Active SOSA are a team combined of adults and children with learning disabilities. They have been training Netball since September 2014 at Westminster Lodge, St Albans. The sessions are funded through a Sport England Sportivate project and Hertfordshire County Netball Association funding. The team turn up early every week, who are keen and ready to get involved, showing fantastic team work and Netball skills.

Their Coach Louise Blay of Kardale Netball club commits fully to ensure the team have a safe, fun and progressive session week in and week out. She states "I was so impressed with the attitude of the team on the day. They are such positive, inspirational people and they made me really proud to be their coach. I love seeing them enjoy playing netball and I love being able to give them that opportunity!"
