#### Dr Anita Navin

Dr Anita Navin has been involved in netball for over 37 years as a performer, coach, talent scout, tutor, coach mentor, education &

training consultant & many more roles to this day.

Anita became International coach for Northern Ireland between 2000 and 2002 and England Netball High Performance Coach between 2002 and 2008. She is part of the Higher Education platform group with the International Council for Coaching Excellence and is a member of the Global Netball Advisory Panel for coaching as part of the International Federation. In 2011 Anita was awarded UK Coach Educator of the Year.

#### WORKSHOP - Purposeful practice when "Getting free ie losing your player"

Focusing on linking the session with the session outcome, the age and stage of the players, the context, the amount of thinking / physical time.



#### Maggie Jackson MBE

Following a successful career as an England player, Maggie began her coaching pathway. Formerly the Head

Coach for Hertfordshire Mavericks, Maggie led her team to win 2 Superleague titles over a six year period. Maggie was involved with coaching and the development of the England Squad between 2004 and 2011, as an assistant coach and also led England to Bronze Medal in Delhi 2010.

In 2011 Maggie received an MBE in recognition for her hard work and services to netball.

#### Denise Ellis

Denise currently works as the National Academy Assistant Coach having previously been Welsh

Denise also works for Team Bath leading the High Performance Programme and was Assistant Coach for Team Bath, Superleague Franchise until 2013. Denise is also heavily involved in the South West Performance programme.

Sam is the Performance Pathway Coach for the East Region, coaching both Regional Acade-



mies and the Regional Performance Academy. Having coached previously at Bedfordshire County Academy and Team Beds, Sam has developed into an extremely exciting coach for the future.

In her first year as Mavericks Youth Head Coach, Sam led her team to achieve silver medals in the 2014/15 season in both the league and end of season tournament. Sam has recently returned from the Nets World Cup in Australia coaching the England Nets U30 squad.
