For the fortnight beginning 28th February, every team taking part in this fantastic initiative will pledge to donate 10p per goal scored in their weekly fixture. E.g:

Luton Lollypop Ladies 45 (£4.50) v Dunstable Dinner Ladies 33 (£3.30)

Total pledge from each team = £7.80

Umpires are also encouraged to get involved, by swapping their whites for some pinks, and rounding any donations up to the nearest pound. At the end of the match, a willing volunteer needs to collect
