- Lead our objective of achieving 1 status in 2022 & then sustaining that accreditation & strengthening our governance over subsequent years.
- Working with our county netball associations to support them strengthen their governance & achieve & sustain Tier 1 status.
- Review the Regional Constitution on an annual basis to recommend revisions to be considered by the members at the Annual General Meeting.
- Support the Regional Chair & Regional Coordinator in the organisation & administration of the Annual General meeting.
- In conjunction with other members of the Regional Management Board & County Chairs ensure we have a Manual of appropriate policies & regulations to frame our work.
- Actively contribute to the general work of the Regional Management Board as set out in the Regional Plan.

You will need to understand governance, be well organised, an excellent communicator, proactive, a team player with a real passion for netball.

Commitment

An estimated 8-10 hours per month including 5 x 2-hour Regional Management Board, via Zoom, per year; Virtual AGM (60 mins); annual Volunteer Recognition & Celebration event + ad hoc meetings.
