 - Oversee the progression of C to B and B to A umpires.
 - Organise mentoring support to B to A umpires in counties with limited or no senior mentors.
 - Recommend to the Regional Officiating Technical Support Group (TSG), the talented East B umpires for allocation to national events such as National Schools.
 - Maintain the Regional League Umpires contact list.
 - Manage the allocation of umpires to Regional League divisions.
 - Manage enquiries from Lead Mentors regarding matters arising from allocations.
- Liaise with and inform the Regional League Umpire Coordinator of division allocations.
- Managing requests for mentors at Regional Schools and Saracens Mavericks NPL match days.
- Managing the Netball East mentors' database.
- Organising the delivery of new mentors' courses as per demand and current mentor reaccreditation every four years.
- Membership of the Regional Officiating TSG and attend meetings as required.
- Work with the Regional Officiating Lead to manage the Regional Mentoring Budget.
- Ensuring all personal information is managed in accordance with Data Protection regulations.
